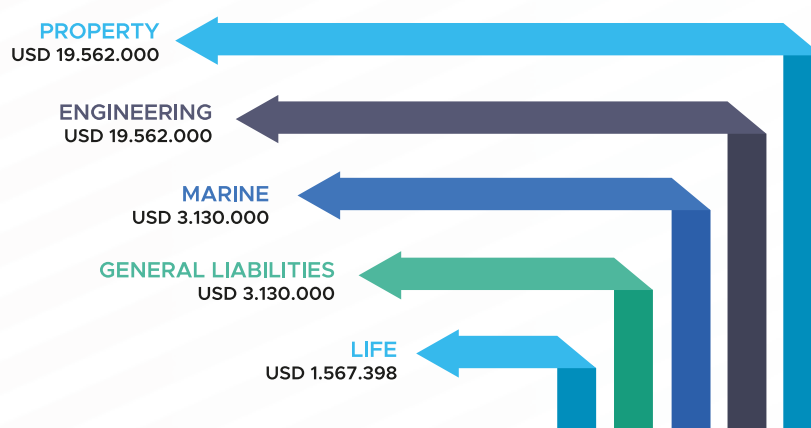
# OF CAPACITIES BY CLASS

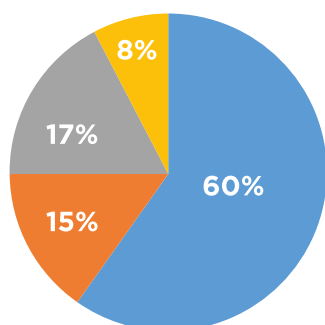

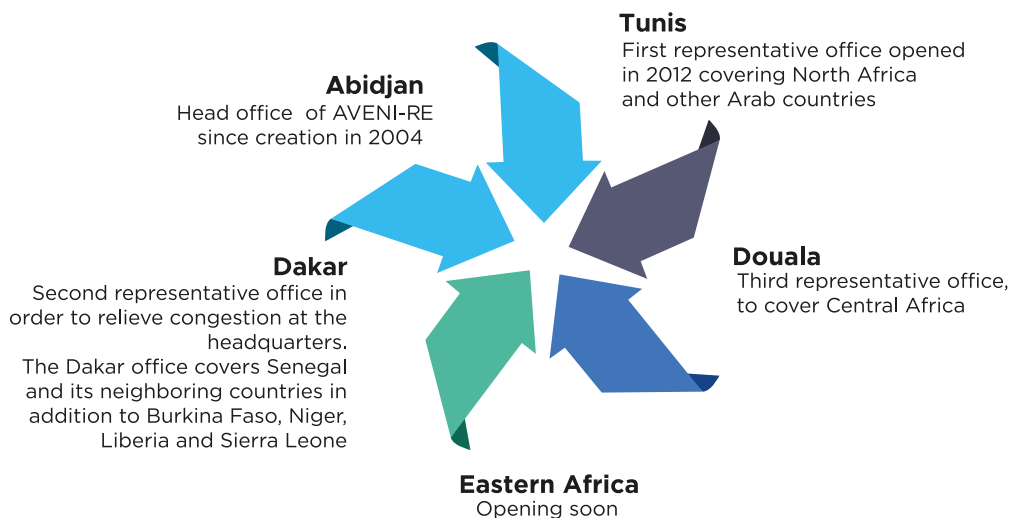
